



# Bayou City Supports Autism Advocacy



Autism is the fastestgrowing developmental disability in the United States affecting 1 in 59 children and 1 in 45 school age children. Over 3,000 children diagnosed on the autism spectrum are enrolled in Fort Bend County public schools.

Hope For Three is the only advocacy group in the Greater Houston area to focus solely on autism.

On December 8th, WM Christopher Houston and the brothers of Bayou City Lodge No. 228-- via a charitable contribution from the Texas Prince Hall Charitable Foundation, presented the organization with a \$500 donation to assist with their Family Assistance program in which the organization provides financial aid to qualified families with children on the autism spectrum residing in Fort Bend County.

The donation will also go to support the Hope For Three's signature awareness campaign, introduced into the public school systems which helps to educate and students, teachers, nurses and counselors about young people with unique differences – autism. This interactive and engaging presentation provides insight on the characteristics of autism, providing students and others a first-hand look at the challenges their differently-able peers endure; as well as providing tips and strategies on how students can be a "good friend" an anti-bullying exercises.
